

How to Access Your Child's Google Classroom



Accessing from Student Chromebook:

1. Open Chromebook. If prompted to login, use your child's login and add the school's domain. For example, if your child's login is msmith, you would login as msmith@ssppcatholic.org. Then follow through with the password listed on the Chromebook.
2. If not prompted, then your child is already logged into the Chromebook.
3. Once your child is logged in, go to the Chrome browser at the bottom of the screen (colorful circle) and open it.
4. In the top right-hand corner, you will see nine dots. Click on that and look for the "Classroom" app. It looks like a green chalkboard. Once it is opened, your child will be in Google Classroom and will see his/her teacher's online classroom.
5. If you do not see the app, just type classroom.google.com in the address bar, and it will appear.

Accessing from a Laptop:

1. Open your internet browser and type classroom.google.com.
2. You will be prompted to type your child's login and password.
3. Login with your child's login and add the school's domain. For example, if your child's login is msmith, you would login as msmith@ssppcatholic.org.
4. You are now logged into google. If you are taken to Classroom immediately, then go to the upper right-hand corner, and you will see nine dots. Click on that and look for the "Classroom" app. It looks like a green chalkboard. Once it is opened, your child will be in Google Classroom and will see his/her teacher's online classroom.
