PK REGISTRATION

On behalf of the Ss. Peter and Paul School Community, we would like to thank you for considering a Catholic education for your child. We know that whether you are enrolling your child in school for the first time or changing schools to offer your child the best education possible, there is stress involved. Our goal is to make this transition as easy as possible. As always, please contact the school office if you have questions.

Please note the following registration guidelines:

- 1. Age Requirements: (All students must be toilet trained to attend school.)
 - a. Pre-Kindergarten 3: Students must be 3 on or before June 30, 2022.
 - b. Pre-Kindergarten 4: Students must be 4 on or before June 30, 2022.
- 2. Tuition Assistance: The Tuition Assistance Program for PK-6 strives to assist Catholic families who desire a Catholic education for their child. You are encouraged to apply once you have received an official acceptance letter from the school. You may apply online at: https://www.factstuitionaid.com. Additional TAP information is available on the school website and on the tuition/fees schedule. There is a nonrefundable fee of \$17.50.
- 3. All fees, signed tuition agreement and completed tuition payment information are required prior to the first day of school.
- 4. Each family must have all required documents prior to official enrollment at Saints Peter and Paul School. This includes a copy of the child's birth certificate, immunization record, and baptism certificate (if Catholic). Other academic documents will be required depending on the age of your child. If a child's academic record is not received in full, the student will be placed on probationary status until all records are received.

Please be reminded that enrollment is confirmed once all registration fees are paid in full and all records, immunizations, and pertinent registration information is completed. Ss. Peter and Paul School administration reserves the right to deny enrollment of any child due to parental non-compliance of rules and misrepresentation of child or family information (i.e. age, health information, past academic records, church affiliation, etc.).

Visitors are welcome and all prospective parents are encouraged to make an appointment to tour the school.

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ALL STUDENTS TUITION AND FEES

The actual cost of educating at child at Ss. Peter and Paul Catholic School is \$5,500 per student. The school absorbs the tuition difference in order to maintain lower tuition rates. That is the reason that fundraisers are important to keep costs down.

Preschool

\$3,250 per child (no Catholic discounts apply to Preschool)

*There is a \$100 non-refundable registration fee due at time of enrollment to hold your child's place in the class.

The fee is applied towards your tuition.

Tuition Payment

The school will collect tuition through FACTS, which automatically debits your checking/savings or credit card each month on the day of your choice (5th, 15th, or 20th).

ALL FAMILIES TUITION AGREEMENT

It is the policy of Ss. Peter & Paul School to require that parents sign a tuition agreement at the time of student registration each year. To ensure proper management of the school, tuition must be paid in a timely manner. This agreement holds parents responsible for tuition payments and any other collection fees incurred should tuition become delinquent.

Terms and Conditions of the Tuition Agreement:

- 1. All tuition is paid through FACTS Tuition Management and deducted from your checking/savings account or credit card.
- 2. A ten-month payment schedule has been established for the payment of tuition with the first payment in August and the last payment in May. If tuition is greater than 30 days in arrears, you will be required to meet with the principal. If good faith efforts to bring tuition payments current are lacking, the school reserves the right to withhold academic records and/or dismiss the student(s) from Ss. Peter & Paul School.
- 3. Signing this tuition agreement does not obligate parents to the payment of a full-year's tuition if they relocate during the school year or if their child is asked to leave the school for disciplinary or academic reasons. Required tuition payments in those cases will be prorated, based on the days that the student(s) is (are) enrolled.
- 4. Failure to sign this agreement will result in the withdrawal of any student from school when tuition becomes delinquent.
- 5. If an emergency occurs during the year, which may delay or restrict a parent's ability to pay tuition in a timely manner, it is required that you contact the principal.
- 6. Parents who are requesting financial assistance will be held accountable for tuition payments. When the amount of financial assistance for the year has been determined and conveyed to them in writing, this will be applied to the account and the monthly payment will be adjusted. Tuition assistance requests for students must be completed and submitted by April 29, 2022, to assure consideration.
- 7. Registration fees are nonrefundable. The \$100 per student registration fee holds the student's placement in the class.
- 8. All incidentals must be enrolled in autopay via FACTS SIS.
